Lexis-Nexis Academic provides full text access to over 6,000 sources including newspapers, journals, news wire services, newsletters, campus publications, company reports, case law, government documents, trade publications, broadcast transcripts, and selected reference works. . It is updated continuously with most of its sources going back until 1990. This guide will give you an overview of the types of information you can find in each category. 	LEGAL NEWS	Law and business journals but not general newspapers
	STATE LEGAL RESEARCH	High and appellate court decisions. Laws in force (codes), new laws (ALS), constitutions, and court rules in Fifty states, D.C., Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands
	U.S. CODE, CONSTITUTION, COURT RULES	Constitution, laws in force, regulations in force, federal acquisitions regulations, Attorney General opinions, and court rules
Medicine	GENERAL MEDICAL AND HEALTH TOPICS	Medical and health journals in full text
	MEDICAL ABSTRACTS	Bibliographic data base of 3500 worldwide medical journals; equivalent of MEDLINE
Reference	BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION	Biographies appearing in biographical dictionaries, magazines, and major newspapers
	COUNTRY PROFILES	Basic statistical data, description of government, key government officials, and a few biographies. Search by name of country
	REFERENCE AND DIRECTORIES	Business directories and quotations
	STATE PROFILES	Geography and symbols, basic population, health, tax, and miscellaneous information for states and territories
