This encyclopedia offers an easy-to-read overview that covers much of the world’s trade, banking and monetary laws.

Encyclopedia of Taxation and Tax Policy (1999)—REF336.2003 1999

Since many instances of fraudulent accounting practices stem from taxation and its avoidance, this encyclopedia can offer a good overview of tax-related issues. Its authors are accountants, policy makers and business executives and the work serves as “a valuable guide” to the debate “over who should pay how much” and other issues.

This work effectively outlines the business histories and timelines of more than 1,500 prominent corporations including notable scandals.

Corporate Record Keeping Made E-Z (2001) REF 657.9042 2001
