Reference Books

Handbook of Research and Policy in Art Education (2004)—REF 707 H236 2004

Geared towards the educational community in general, this handbook offers a core body of scholarship organized in six main sections: Policy in Art Education, Learning in Art, Assessment, Historical Currents in Art Education, Teaching and Teacher Education and Emerging Visions of Art Education.

The Art Teacher's Book of Lists (1998)—REF 702 H921a

Offers information about specific artists, art materials, art history, museums and disciplines. Includes information for lesson plan, projects and rubrics. Of special importance is the section "For the Art Teacher".

Education Reform (2004)—REF 370 F911e

Includes a chronology of events and an annotated bibliography covering the past 50 years in education reform.

Taking Sides: Clashing Views on Controversial Educational Issues (2004)—REF 307.1 T136

Introduce students to controversies in education.

Learning Theories A to Z (2002)—REF 370 L581L

Presents about 500 terms related to learning theory and links them to four categories: cognitivism, constructive, behaviorism, and humanism.

ART: A Field Guide (2001)—REF 700 C971a

Evaluations of more than 770 painters, 680 explanations of symbols and stories of Western art, 650 definitions of artistic techniques, media, tools, movements and styles.

Critical Terms for Art History (2003)—REF 701 C934

Contains a collection of essays from a range of writers who share their thought about the shifting boundaries of art history.
