This subject guide will help you access Photography-related resources in the Miller Library. This guide will lead you to reference materials, books, journals, magazines, newspapers, associations, internet resources & government documents available through the Library's holdings, services and databases. It will also direct you to on-line locations of full-text journals. As always, carefully evaluate all sources before you choose to integrate them into your papers, assignments and presentations.

Photography is a broad term covering Photojournalism, Nature Photography, Digital Photography, Daguerreotype, and Fashion Photography as well as a number of elements and composition. This guide will help provide general information that will be helpful in the beginning stages of research. If you have a very specific topic in mind, consult more specific subject guides that more closely examine your chosen area.
